#### Scholarship Categories

- Active duty, drilling reservist, or National Guard member
- Spouse of active duty, drilling reservist, National Guard member, or military retiree
- Child of active duty, drilling reservist, National Guard member, or military retiree
- Permanently disabled military member or family member (spouse or child) or family member of service member missing/killed in action
- Veteran or retiree of the Armed Forces

#### Required Documentation

1. VA-ACME Scholarship Application form
2. Headshot
2. Unofficial transcript(s)
3. Two letters of recommendation from academia, professional, or community member who can attest to your motivation, character, and integrity
4. Evidence of eligibility to enroll (institutions letter of acceptance or registration)
5. Statement of community service (found in body of application)
6. Essay topic: ***As a member of the military community, how has your experience influenced your educational goals?*** (found in body of application)

*Incomplete applications will not be considered*

All scholarship applications must be typewritten and submitted along with supporting documentation to [scholarships@vaacme.org](mailto:scholarships@vaacme.org) by April 3, 2020. Awardees are notified by phone and email on or about April 10, 2020. Payments are made directly to the institution for the Fall 2020 semester. Members of the VA-ACME board, VA-ACME Scholarship Committee, and their families are not eligible to apply. Only one application per person will be accepted.
